January 4, 2010* (E-155)	Signature in lieu collection period begins for all candidates.
February 1, 2010 (E-127)	First day candidates for judicial offices may file the Declaration of Intention.
February 1, 2010 (E-127)	Last day to file semi-annual campaign statements (from last statement to 12/31/09). Date adjusted from Sunday to Monday.
February 10, 2010 (E-118)	Last day for judicial candidates to file the Declaration of Intent. This period is extended if the incumbent does not file.
February 16, 2010* (E-112)	Close of extended filing period for the Declaration of Intention.
February 16, 2010* (E-112)	Candidate filing begins.
February 17, 2010 (E-111)	Last day for statewide candidates to submit a candidate statement to the Secretary of State for inclusion in the State Voter Guide
February 25, 2010 (E-103)	Signature in lieu collection period closes for all candidates.
March 12, 2010 (E-88)	Close of regular candidate filing period. Extended candidate filing period begins for some offices.
March 17, 2010 (E-83)	Close of extended candidate filing period.
March 18, 2010 (E-82)	Random alphabet draw to be held at 11AM to determine the ballot order of candidates' names.
March 22, 2010 (E-78)	Last day to file 1 st pre-election campaign statements (from last statement to 3/17/10).
April 12, 2010 (E-57)	Write-in candidate filing period begins
April 29, 2010 (E-40)	Sample ballots may begin to be mailed.
May 10, 2010 (E-29)	First day to process vote by mail ballot requests.
May 24, 2010 (E-15)	Last day to register for this election.
May 25, 2010 (E-14)	Write-in candidate filing period ends.
May 27, 2010 (E-12)	Last day to file 2 nd pre-election campaign statements (from last statement to 5/22/10).
June 1, 2010 (E-7)	Last day to request vote by mail ballot by mail.
June 8, 2010	ELECTION DAY
