

## INFO. ON SAME-DAY REGISTRATION

On September 24, 2012 the Governor signed into law AB1436 establishing conditional voter registration, which allows a voter to register after the 15<sup>th</sup> day prior to an election or on Election Day, and cast a provisional ballot. **The law WILL NOT be operative for the November 6, 2012 Presidential Election. The close of registration for the November Election is October 22, 2012.**

On October 22, 2012 after 5PM Placer County Office of Elections will place a table outside of the office where voters can complete a voter registration card. Voters can also complete a voter registration online at [www.sos.ca.gov](http://www.sos.ca.gov), or pick one up at local post offices and libraries.

The new law will become operative on January 1 of the year following the year in which the Secretary of State certified that the state has a statewide voter registration database that complies with the requirements of the federal Help American Vote Act of 2002.
