Dear Voter,

Recently our office received your Vote-by-Mail ballot for the November 8, 2016 Presidential General Election. Unfortunately the return envelope did not contain your signature. By law, in order to process your ballot your signature must be provided on your return ballot envelope.

In order to count your ballot, please complete the enclosed Unsigned Ballot Statement and return it to the Office of Elections for processing. We must receive your signed statement before 5:00 pm on November 16th. Postmarks cannot count.

You may return the completed statement by one of the following methods:

- **By Mail:** Your statement may be returned by mail using the enclosed return envelope.
- **In Person to the Placer County Office of Elections:** The Office of Elections is located at 2956 Richardson Drive in Auburn and offers full service for voters Monday through Friday from 8:00 am – 5:00 pm, or 9:00 am – 4:00 pm on the following weekends: October 29th/30th and November 5th/6th. The Office of Elections will also be open during Memorial Day and the extended business hours of 7:00 am to 8:00 pm on Election Day, November 8th. For after hours service, you may deposit your ballot in our 24-hour, drive-up, drop-off ballot box located in front of our office.
- **In Person to any Placer County Polling Place:** Your statement may be delivered in person to any Placer County polling place on Election Day. Polling place hours are 7:00 am to 8:00 pm. For a list of polling places, visit: www.placerelections.com or call the Office of Elections at: (530)886-5650.
- **By Fax:** You may return your signed statement by fax to: (530) 886-5682.

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UNSIGNED BALLOT STATEMENT

I, _____ am a registered voter of Placer County, State of California. I do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I requested and returned a vote by mail ballot and that I have not and will not vote more than one ballot in this election. I understand that if I commit or attempt any fraud in connection with voting, or if I aid or abet fraud or attempt to aid or abet fraud in connection with voting, I may be convicted of a felony punishable by imprisonment for 16 months or two or three years. I understand that my failure to sign this statement means that my vote by mail ballot will be invalidated.

READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE COMPLETING THE STATEMENT. FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS MAY CAUSE YOUR BALLOT NOT TO COUNT.

- In order to ensure that your vote by mail ballot will be counted, your statement should be completed and returned as soon as possible so that it can reach the elections official of the county in which your precinct is located no later than 5 p.m. on the eighth day after the election.
- You must sign your name on the line above (Voter's Signature).
- Place the statement into a mailing envelope addressed to your local elections official. Mail, deliver, or have delivered the completed statement to the elections official. Be sure there is sufficient postage if mailed and that the address of the elections official is correct.
- Alternatively, you may submit your completed statement by facsimile transmission to your local elections official, or submit your completed statement to a polling place within the county or a ballot drop off box before the close of the polls on Election Day. (E.C. 3019)
